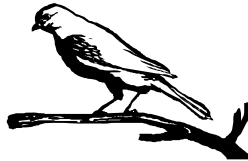


STONY BROOK WILDLIFE SANCTUARY RENTAL INFORMATION

Stony Brook's Nature Center houses a children's discovery room, a gift shop, restrooms, a kitchen, and several meeting rooms. Guests are welcome to enjoy Stony Brook's trails and grounds during conference breaks. If you are interested in a guided tour of the Sanctuary or a more formal educational program, please contact us for more information, scheduling, and fees.

Stony Brook Wildlife Sanctuary is cooperatively managed by the Massachusetts Audubon Society and the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation. The Sanctuary encompasses 245 acres of forest, field, and wetland habitats, each offering exciting opportunities for nature exploration. The 2 miles of trails on the Sanctuary include a scenic boardwalk across a pond and marsh.

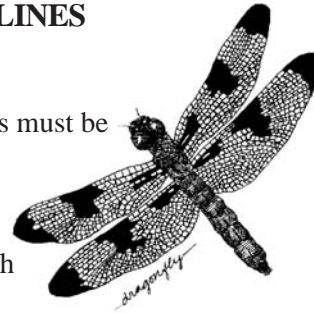
DEPOSIT REQUIREMENTS

Standard Half or Full Day Rental:
\$50 nonrefundable deposit for rental
\$50 refundable security deposit

Nonprofit Organization Rental:
\$25 nonrefundable deposit for rental
\$25 refundable security deposit

FACILITY GUIDELINES

Set-up and decorations must be approved prior to the event. The arrival of tents, caterers, etc., must be scheduled with the Sanctuary staff at least one week prior to the event.



Caterers must provide their own dinnerware, etc. and must provide a signed contract and damage deposit at least two weeks prior to the rental.

All trash and garbage (except recyclable bottles and cans) must be removed from the premises at the end of the function.

A nonrefundable deposit and signed rental agreement, as well as a refundable security deposit, are required to confirm a rental.

All rental balances are due two weeks prior to the rental date.

Tables and chairs are for indoor use only.

Smoking is prohibited.

Directions To Stony Brook

From 495: Take Exit #15 (Rt. 1A North). Follow 1A North for 4 miles to Rt. 115. Turn left on 115N and go 1.5 miles. Take the 3rd left on to North Street. The Sanctuary is 100 yards up on the right.

From 95S: Take exit #9 (Rt. 1S). After Gillette Stadium, take a right on Pine St. At the stop sign take a right on to Rt. 115N. Cross Rt. 1A and take the 3rd left at North Street. The Sanctuary is 100 yards up on the right.

From 95N: Take Exit 7 (Rt. 140N) Follow to Rt. 115N. Cross Rt. 1A and take the 3rd left at North Street. The Sanctuary is 100 yards up on the right.

From 115N: Follow 115S through 2 roundabouts in Norfolk Center. Continue on 115 for approximately 1 mile. Take a right at North Street. The Sanctuary is 100 yards up on the right.
