All Persons Trail/Fisher Trail

Length: 1.2 miles (roundtrip)

The Fisher Trail begins at the main parking area and wanders through mixed forest before passing the edge of a meadow and then proceeding downhill to inspiring views of the Concord River. Be sure to stop and look for wildlife—ducks, herons, and turtles—when crossing the dam that separates the marsh from the river. This accessible All Persons Trail has a firm and stable surface of crushed stone. The grade of the first 0.4 mile of trail is at 5% or less, with the exception of four short sections (50-65' in length each) where slopes are up to 8%. The remaining 0.2 mile of trail between the meadow and the river has steeper rolling terrain, where grades are consistently between 5-9%. Several seating areas are available along the trail.
