



Superbowl of Birding Fledgling Award Rules and Checklist

Objective: Be the first team to find and identify all of the bird species listed on the Fledgling Award Checklist.

Rules Specific to the Fledgling Award Competition: Teams must comply with all of the other Superbowl of Birding rules in addition to the following:

- 1. To win the Fledgling Award, a team must be the first team to notify the Superbowl of Birding judges that they have completed the Fledgling Award Checklist below. If no team completes the Fledgling Award Checklist, then the team that sees the most species on the checklist wins. The telephone number for the Superbowl of Birding judges is 978-462-9998.
- 2. At least two of the Fledgling Team members must be 16 years old or younger.
- 3. A team claiming the Fledgling Award cannot win any other team award.
- 4. Members of a Fledgling Team are also eligible for the Lifer Award.
