Wellfleet Bay Wildlife Sanctuary CAMPING RULES AND REGULATIONS

During your visit, we hope you enjoy the natural world and appreciate your role as a neighbor to the sanctuary's plants and animals.

We are a wildlife sanctuary. Please leave all forms of wildlife undisturbed. **DO NOT FEED ANY WILDLIFE.** We are also a people sanctuary. Be considerate of your neighbor's right to quiet and harmony.

Rules and Regulations:

- 1. FIRE IS OUR MAJOR HAZARD.** Use ashtrays; build **no open fires**. Campfires and firepits are not allowed. Gas stoves are always acceptable. Above ground charcoal containers can be used with care. Do not use grill in strong wind; attend it constantly; douse coals and, **when cold**, empty ash in trash barrel. **Do not** bury your charcoal. If a fire risk has been declared, the use of charcoal may be temporarily prohibited. Sanctuary staff will keep you informed of any changes.
- 2.** Overnight use of a campsite is limited to Mass Audubon members. Groups of no more than 8 people may camp together on the same site. All family members 21 years and over **must** have their own membership.
- 3.** Limit of two vehicles (car, truck, boat, motorcycle, trailer) per campsite. Cars should be parked at the front of the campsite, not driven back into the site. The main parking lot **cannot** be used to park extra vehicles. Please leave your vehicle placard visible on your dashboard.
- 4.** Limit of four structures (tents, pop-up trailers, teardrop trailers, tarps, screened enclosures, etc.) per site. Camping structures should be set up within your campsite area in the vicinity of the picnic table. Picnic tables can be moved within your campsite, but you will be asked to move any structures set up outside the designated area.
- 5.** Pets are not allowed, with the exception of service dogs. Service dogs must be indicated at the time of reservation. Please read our [Service Animal Statement](#).
- 6.** Please only use water spigots to fill containers for use back at your campsite. Please no washing dishes, clothes, hair, etc. at water spigots. Do not use the showers to wash boogie/surf boards, dishes, and clothes.
- 7.** Accompany young children to restrooms and along trails.
- 8.** This is primarily a wildlife sanctuary and any recreational activities such as bicycle riding, frisbee, ball playing, jogging, etc. must take place off sanctuary grounds. For the safety of our visitors and wildlife, bike riding on the paved and dirt roads within the sanctuary and jogging on trails is prohibited.
- 9.** Check-out time is **no later than 10:00 am on the date of your departure**. Campers will forfeit their \$50 deposit for late checkouts. Our staff always appreciates guests leaving their site clean. Thank you!
